

Privacy and Information Practices Disclosures - Wellness

The information that you provide in the course of responding to the questions on this site will be provided to the health care provider that sent the invitation to participate as part of your use of the Elminda Brain Network Analytics (BNA) technology and use and disclosure of the information collected will be subject to the privacy policies of your provider and as described below.

Information collection. The questions ask you to provide certain information about your personal and family medical history. Each question is optional, although the more information that you provide, the more information is available to your provider along with the BNA technology.

These forms are through a third-party service provider on behalf of health care providers that use the BNA technology. Elminda does not request your name, address, telephone number or other direct identifiers through this site. Your health care provider, however, can identify you and connect your identity to your responses on the basis of a code that was embedded in your invitation to participate in questions on this site. As a result, you should only access the questions on this site using the invitation that was sent to you by your health care provider.

Use by Elminda. Elminda uses your responses—but does not receive your name or other direct identifiers—to provide support to your healthcare provider, to improve the BNA technology, and to meet our legal and regulatory obligations.

Disclosures. Elminda will disclose the information you provide to the health care provider that invited you to participate. Information also may be shared with our service providers, subject to confidentiality protections. As part of our regulatory obligations, regulators such as the Food and Drug Administration may be able to inspect and access information about you by name.

Access and Correction. If you notice that you answered a question incorrectly, you can correct the response before submitting the answers. For access to, or to request correction of, any information that you submit in response to a question on the site after you have submitted it, please contact your healthcare provider.

Security. Elminda utilizes reasonable administrative, physical, and technical safeguards to protect personal information that is submitted through this site.

Cookies/Online Tracking. This site does not track the activities of users across websites over time nor does the site respond to web browser “do not track” signals. The site may use "cookies," web beacons and other similar technologies on our website. If you do not want us to deploy browser cookies to your device when you visit our websites, you may set the browser to reject cookies or to notify the user when a web site tries to place cookies in the browser program. Rejecting cookies may affect your ability to use some of features offered by the website. If you use our website without setting your browser to block cookies, you consent to the placement of cookies on your device.

Children. This site is not intended or designed to attract users under the age of 13 or to collect personal information from such users. We do not collect personally identifiable data from any person we know to be under the age of 13 and those under 13 should not submit any personal information through this site. If we learn that we have inadvertently collected personal information from a child under the age of 13 we will remove the information from our files. If an individual under 13 is using BNA technology, the questions should be completed by the child’s parent.

Policy changes. In the event of any material changes to the privacy practices described above affecting the information you have previously provided, these changes will be communicated to you through your healthcare provider.
